BASED ON THE FILE, RECORD, AND PROCEEDINGS, AND BECAUSE:

1. This appeal was filed on October 6, 2025. Appellant Kellye Strickland's statement of the case indicates that the transcript has already been delivered to the parties and filed with the district court administrator. Appellant's brief and addendum were due on November 5, 2025. *See* Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 131.01, subd. 1 (requiring the appellant's brief and addendum to be served and filed within 30 days after the filing of the notice of appeal if the transcript is obtained prior to appeal).

2. Our records do not reflect that appellant has filed a brief and addendum or a motion for an extension. We will afford appellant a final opportunity to serve and file a brief and addendum as directed below. Because appellant is self-represented, appellant may file an informal brief and addendum.

3. An informal brief shall contain a concise statement of the party's arguments on appeal, together with the addendum required by Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 130.01. Minn.

R. Civ. App. P. 128.01, subd. 1. The informal brief shall have a cover and any paper copy may be bound by stapling. *Id.*

4. The addendum filed with appellant's brief must include a copy of the December 12, 2024 order being appealed. *See* Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 130.02(a) (governing appealing party's addendum).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Appellant Kellye Strickland shall serve and file a brief and addendum by December 1, 2025. The addendum filed with appellant's brief must contain a copy of the December 12, 2024 order being appealed.

2. On or before December 1, 2025, appellant shall file proof of service of appellant's brief and addendum on counsel for respondent Madeline Sally Machla Lee.

3. Appellant's failure to serve and file a brief and addendum by December 1, 2025, may result in the dismissal of this appeal without further notice.
